Currently, 46.4% of the 45,644 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 49.1%, renter occupied; and 4.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 43,300 housing units in the area - 47.2% owner occupied, 47.2% renter occupied, and 5.6% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.37%. Median home value in the area is \$345,779, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.86% annually to \$438,420.
